Motions for AGM

1 Membership rate increase.

Current membership fees of €30/year (practitioners) and €50/year (associate) have remained unchanged for several years. While cognisant of cost of living increases the committee is also of the opinion that in order to maintain the financial viability of the association and to continue to support our members and promote advanced practice, an increase in membership fees is required.

Motion:

1.1 Membership rate for Candidate & Registered Advanced Nurse and Midwife Practitioners will increase to €50 per year.

1.2 Membership rate for Associate Members will increase to €75 per year.

2 Renewal period and process – constitutional amendment

In order to streamline the registration process and in response to queries from members who sign up later in the calendar year, who are then required to renew within 12 months, the committee proposes the following change to the constitution.

Current:

Membership shall be renewed annually in January at a cost of €30.00 and confirmed by means of an official receipt. Associate members are required to pay a fee of €50.00.

Fees shall be paid on an annual basis to the Treasurer at the time of the AGM to ensure membership for the coming year. Fees to be paid from April to April [pre AGM].

Proposed:

The annual membership fee of €** for Advanced Nurse/Midwife Practitioners and Candidates, and €** for Associate Members is paid on member registration via the association website with an email receipt. Membership will renew automatically on the anniversary of the first registration following a notification email in advance to the member.

**membership fees applicable subject to AGM decision on motion 1.

3 Committee membership and officer roles – constitutional amendment

As the association has grown and membership of the committee has changed, the committee is of the opinion that it may be useful to have, at times, co-shared roles for the named positions on the committee. This would allow for collaborative leadership, division of workload, and aid in building capacity among committee members for the future.
